

Conference Location

The event is being held at the Technology and Innovation Centre (TIC), University of Strathclyde, 99 George Street, Glasgow, G1 1RD, UK.

Lectures will take place in Auditorium B/C, while lunches, coffee, dinner, poster sessions and sponsor exhibits will be in the adjacent foyer, over Levels 2 and 3 of TIC (ground and first floors). There is access to a quiet room for prayer/meditation and a luggage storeroom (unattended). Please ask for details on arrival.

Walking

TIC is ~7 mins from Queen Street train station (trains to North and East), ~15 mins from Glasgow Central train station (trains to South and West) and ~15 mins from Buchanan Bus Station (coaches).

By bus

There are many bus stops close to TIC – for full details, see the First Bus website at www.firstbus.co.uk/greater-glasgow. The airport bus is nr 500 and stops are marked on the adjacent map. It terminates at Buchanan Station.

By train

Trains from the West and South (e.g. London) terminate at Glasgow Central Station, while most trains from the North and East terminate at Queen Street Station. Please note that there will be

By coach

Glasgow is served by most large coach operators (e.g. National Express or MegaBus). Services terminate at Buchanan Bus Station.

By air

Glasgow Airport is approx. 10 miles from the City Centre; please see www.glasgowairport.com/to-and-from/ for transport options to the city. Edinburgh Airport is approx. 40 miles away, with a direct coach connection to Glasgow (see www.citylink.co.uk/timetables-service-updates/glasgow-to-edinburgh-airport/).

Parking

Discounted parking is available at 24hr City Parking Duke Street (validate ticket at TIC reception - £5/day) and 24hr NCP Montrose Street (Download the ParkPass app; use code GVTR4X - £7/12hrs).
